Description of the scheme	<p>Provide effective and seamless backward and forward integration for processed food industry.</p> <p>Financial assistance is provided for setting up of primary processing centres/collection centres at farm gate and modern retail outlets at front end along with connectivity through insulated/refrigerated transport.</p> <p>Applicable to perishable horticulture and non-horticulture produce, ready to cook food products, honey, coconut, spices, mushroom, retails shops for perishable food products, etc.</p>
